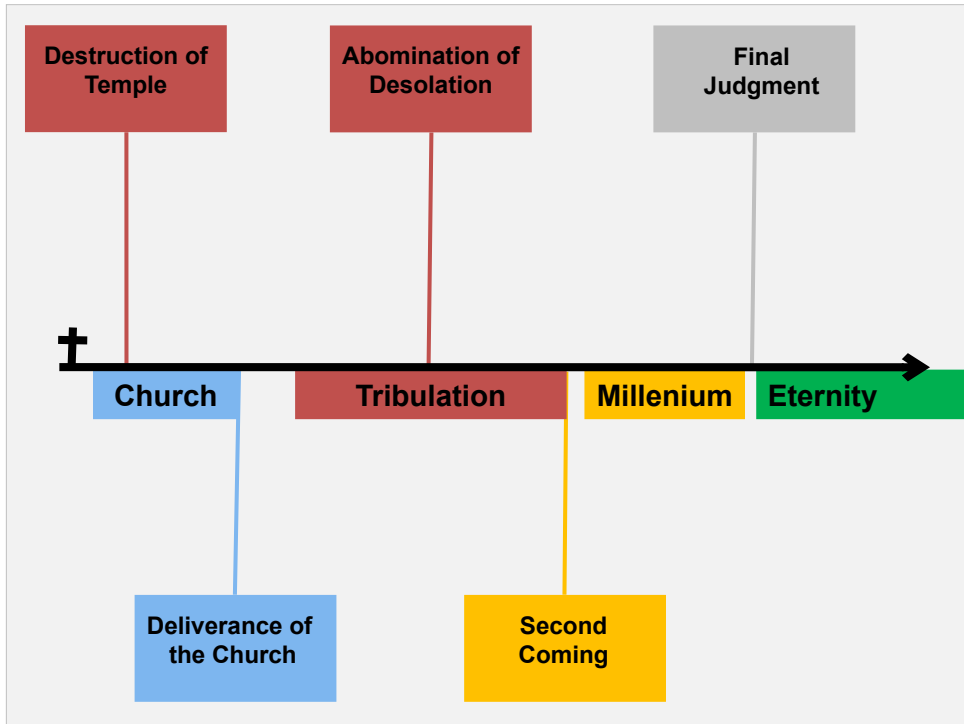




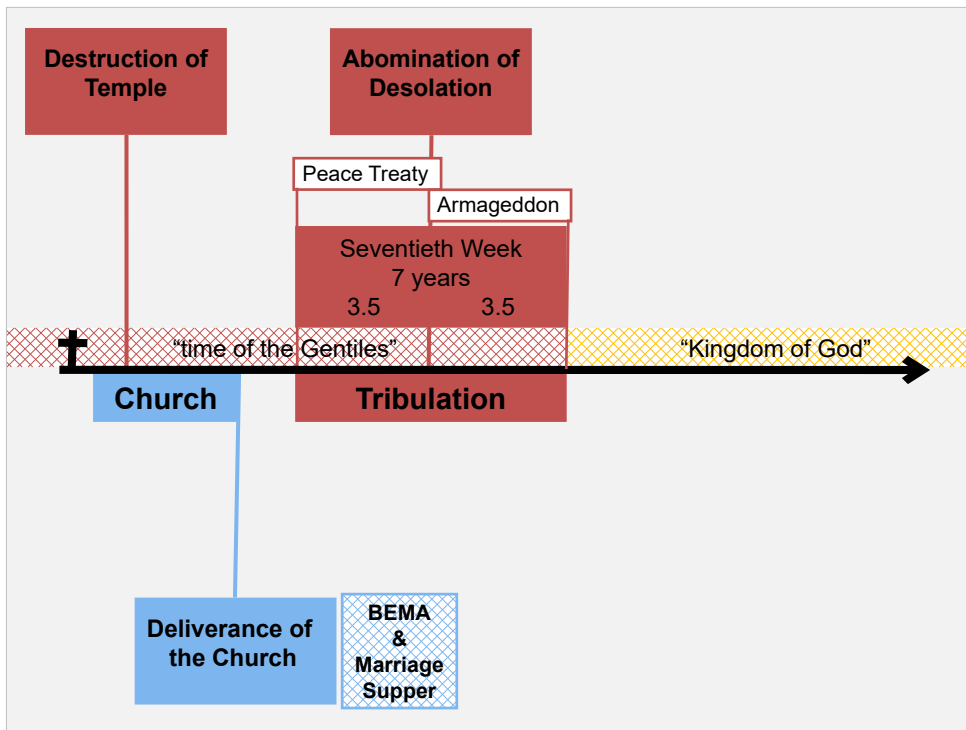
Jacopo Vignali [Public domain] - Artist impression of John receiving Revelation

- > Church age and the end of the church age
- > Final Judgements on the wicked and on the earth
- > Eternity

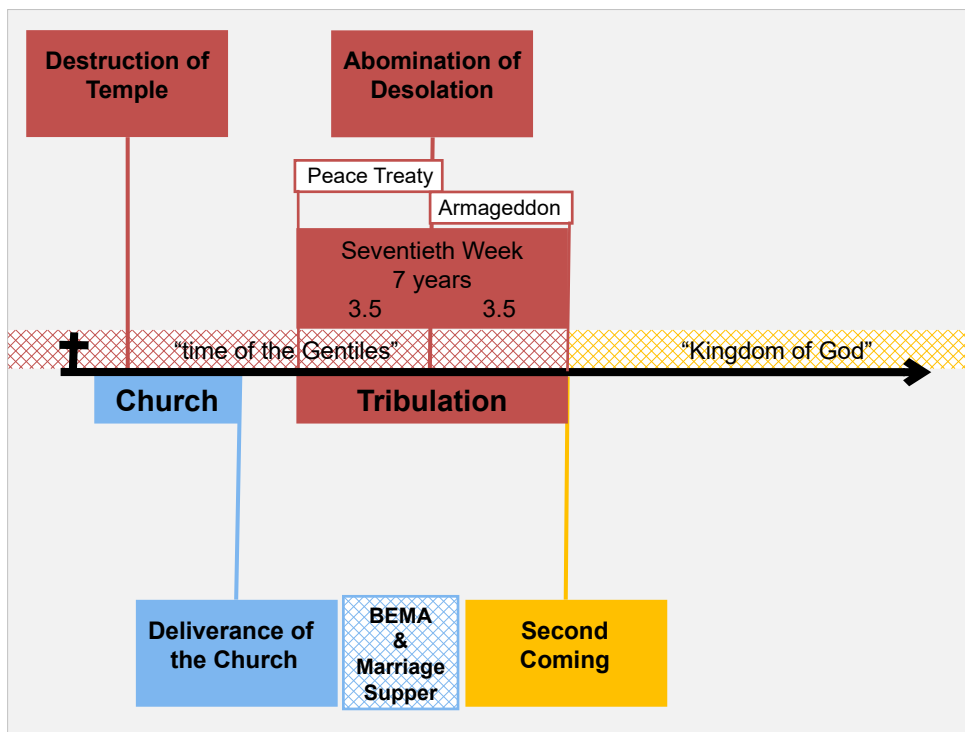


REVIEW

See handout of verses for each section

- > Believers attend BEMA judgment (rewards) and are the bride at the Marriage Supper of the Lamb (possibly after 2nd Coming)
- > This is the 70th week of Daniel divided in half - 3.5 yrs each
- > This Tribulation period starts with the Prince of this world signing a Peace Treaty with Israel
- > The Tribulation culminates in the Battle of Armageddon
- > This entire period, from the original destruction of Jerusalem when Daniel was still a young man is known as the 'time of the Gentiles'
- > From this point forward it is called 'The Kingdom of God'

> Second Coming

Trib. ends abruptly when Jesus returns as King winning the battle of Armageddon. He arrives with the church saints to reign over the world

Rev 16 (bowls) The earth is destroyed

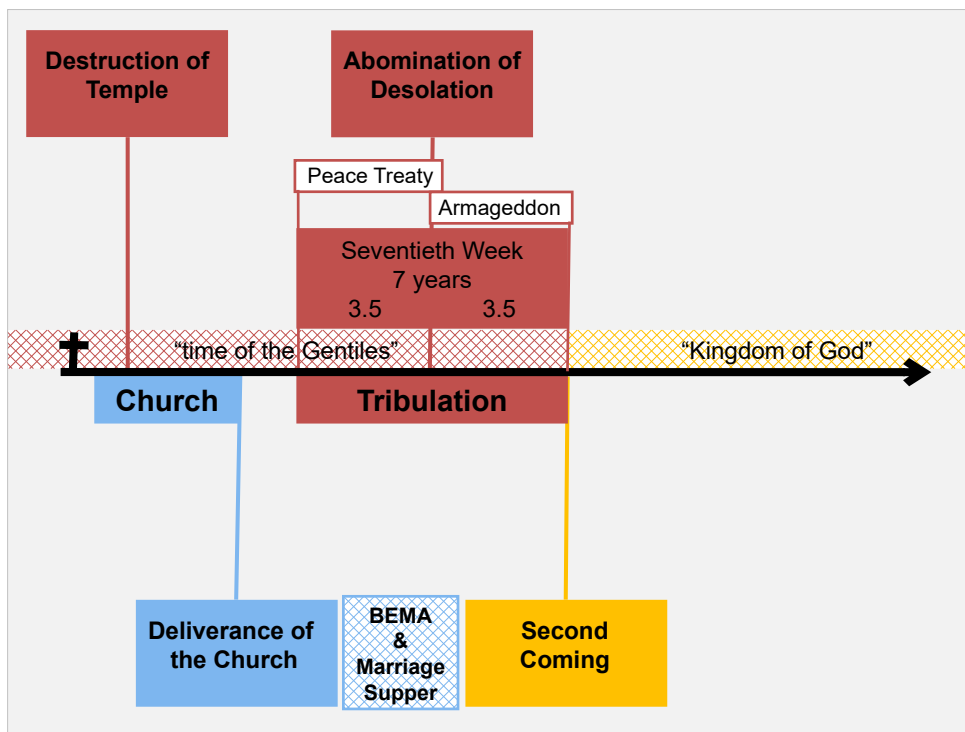
Rev 17:12-14a; Zech 14:3-5 Battle of Armageddon is arranged

Then Christ shows up **Zech 14:6-7 (12-15)**

Matt 24:30-31; Mk 13:26-27; Lk 21:27;

POINT: How we are to think about the Tribulation-Coming-Kingdom period?

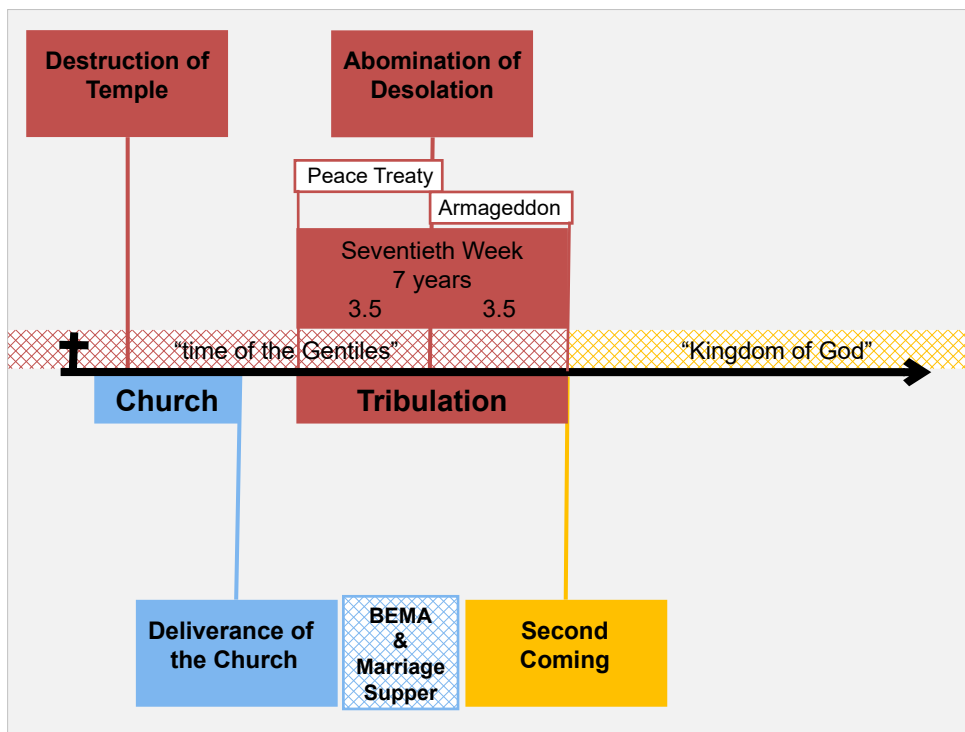
Anticipate the Kingdom: **Matt 24:32-33; Mk 13:28-29; Lk 21:28-31**

Rest in the definite timeframe: **Matt 24:34; Mk 13:30; Lk 21:32**

Be very assured: **Matt 24:35; Mk 13:31; Lk 21:33**

Unknown hour (not rapture; for judgment): **Matt 24:36-41; Mk 13:32**

Be Watchful: **Matt 24:42-51; Mk 13:33-37; Lk 21:34-36**



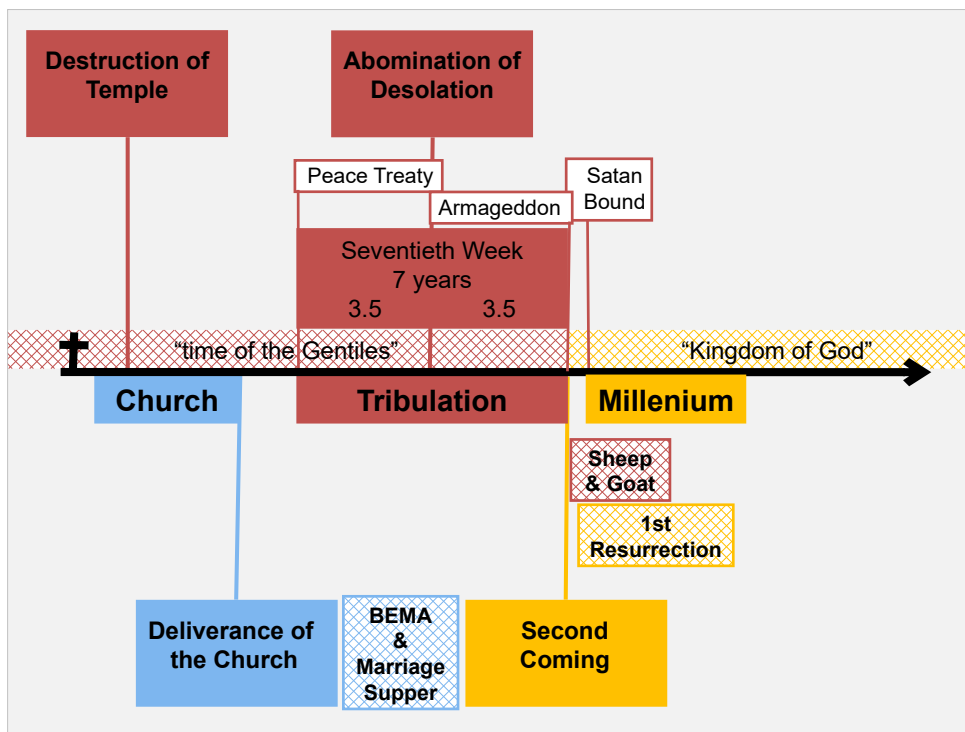
Back to events:

At the Arrival of Jesus ...

Dan 12:1; Zech 12:10; 13:1, 8-9 Israel will be saved (Rom 11)

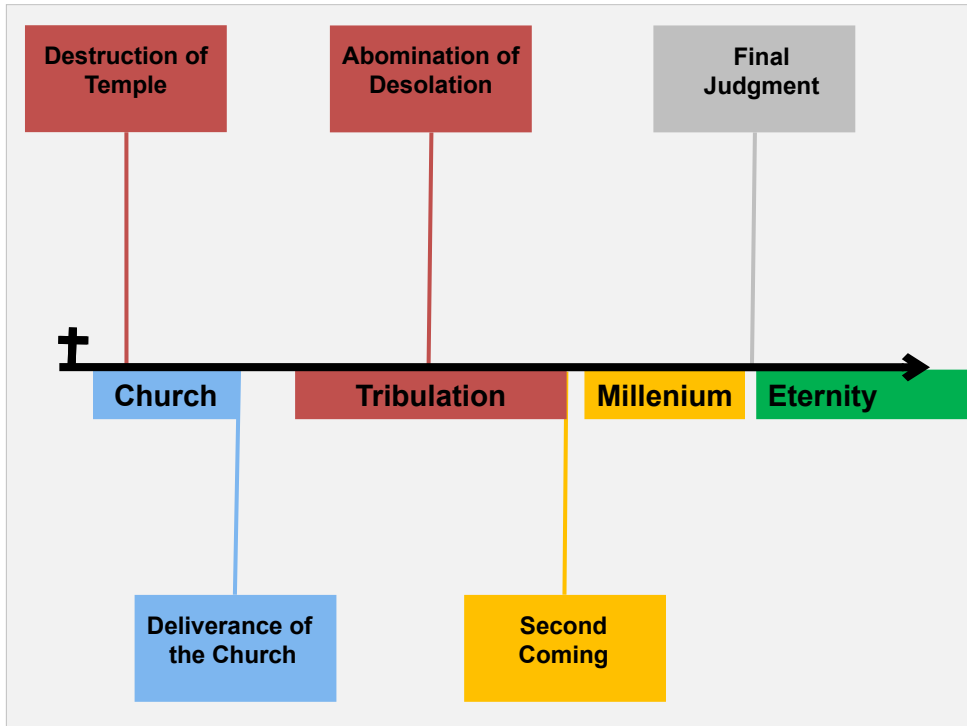
Dan 9:27c the desolator will be destroyed (ending the 70th week)

Rev 19:17-21; (Zech 14:12-15) the Battle of Armageddon will be ended



NEXT TIME: sneak preview

- > The Sheep/Goat judgment then takes place to separate the remaining people into the believers and unbelievers group. The unbelievers are all destroyed and the believers continue with Jesus
- > Satan is bound at the beginning of the Millenium, but is released at the end.
- > The 1st Resurrection takes place, raising all OT saints and Tribulation martyrs to their glorified state.
- > Jesus then sets up His 1000 yrs reign over the world from Jerusalem with only, and all, believers.
